Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's 8th head coach on 3/26/13.

Cooper, 51, begins his 7th season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 242-143-40 record. Cooper's .616 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on 4/11/15, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his first three full seasons and four of his five full seasons as head coach, including three Eastern Conference Finals appearances in the last four seasons (2015, 2016 and 2018) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous 3 seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on 3/29/13.

PLAYER NOTES:

BAIL-OUT:

Alternate captain, Josh Bailey saw his season-long eight-game point streak end in Monday's shootout loss to Montreal. His team-leading point streak is the second longest of his career (11 games, 2017-18) and tied for fourth longest in the NHL at the time. The Bowmanville, ON native leads the Islanders in both points (15) and assists (12) this season.

LEE-ING BY EXAMPLE:

New York Islanders captain Anders Lee recorded a goal in the Islanders 3-2 shootout win over the Penguins on Sunday, moving him into second place on the team goals lead (5). The Edina, MN became the first Islander to record at least 11 points in the opening 10 games since 2015-16. Lee's four power-play goals are T-6th in the NHL.

#100 for #1:

In the Islanders 2-1 win on Sunday in Raleigh, Thomas Greiss 38 saves to earn his 100th career-win. The Islanders goaltender has stopped 134 of 140 shots over his last four starts with a 95.7 save percentage and 1.44 GAA. The Fussen, Germany is 3-0-1 in his last four games including his 100th win on Oct. 26 at CAR and a 35-save shutout on Nov. 3 vs. NJD. On Monday, Greiss appeared in his 128th game, passing Garth Snow for 10th place among Islander goalkeepers.

HIGH FIVE:

In Thursday nights win in Los Angeles, New York Islanders defensemen Thomas Hickey and Scott Mayfield both finished with a +5 rating good for new career-highs. On Thursday, Hickey and Mayfield became the first pair of Islanders defenseman to finish +5 (or better) since March 17, 1990 (Gerald Diduck and Joe Reekie vs. NYR).

TEAM NOTES:

Lou Lamoriello: With Monday's game vs. Montreal, Lou Lamoriello (NYI; 2,400 games) became the third General Manager in NHL history to serve 2,400 games, joining David Poile (2,704; 1st) and Glen Sather (2,700; 2nd).

The New York Islanders are currently riding a **seven-game** point streak (5-0-2). Over their seven-game stretch, the Islanders have outscored their opponents 25-14 including a 35 save shutout on Saturday night against New Jersey. Saturday's win over the Devils was the first time the Islanders have earned two shutouts in their first five home games since 1977.

NYI vs. THE METRO:

The Islanders start the season 6-0-0 against their division tying their best divisional start in franchise history (1982-83). New York finished 5-0-0 in their five-game stretch against the Metropolitan Division. This stint is only the second time that the Isles have ever played at least five consecutive games against Metro opponents.

- The Islanders will play 20 games at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, the team's home since the 2015-16 season. They'll play the remaining 21 home games at NYCB Live Home of the Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum, in Uniondale, where the team called home from 1972-2015.
