## PLAYERS TO WATCH




### JOSH BAILEY #12

Alternate captain, Josh Bailey recorded his second consecutive multi-point game and now has six points (2G, 4A) in his last five games. Bailey, 29, has posted nine multi-point outings his season, second most on the Islanders. The Bowmanville, ON native co-leads the Islanders with 3 GWG this season and is one of five players in the NHL to score multiple shootout-winners this season.



### NICK LEDDY #2

Islanders defenseman, Nick Leddy ranks second among team blueliners with 18 assists in 58 games this season. Leddy, 27, is one of seven Islanders to appear in all 58 games this year and one of just two defenseman (Pulock). The Eden Prairie, MN native had three points (1G, 2A) in two games against the Flames last season.



### JOHNNY GAUDREAU #13

Calgary forward, Johnny Gaudreau leads the Flames in points (78), assists (29), game-winning goals (6) and co-leads the team in goals (29) through 59 games this season. Gaudreau, 25, is one goal shy of hitting the 30-goal mark for the second time in his career and tying his career-high set in 2015-16. The Salem, NJ native ranks fourth in the NHL in points and seventh in assists.

## NEW YORK ISLANDERS QUICK FACTS

### TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:

The New York Islanders open a three-game Western Canada road trip as they take on the Calgary Flames for the first time this season. The Flames are the only team in the NHL the Islanders have not played yet this season. Last season, the Islanders split their series with Calgary, with each team earning a win on the road. The Islanders have won six of their last eight meetings with the Flames.

### LAST TIME OUT:

The New York Islanders scored three third-period goals to top the Edmonton Oilers 5-2 in the final game in Brooklyn of the regular season. **Devon Toews** recorded his first career multi-point game, while **Robin Lehner** improved to 14-3-1 in his last 18 games and the Islanders extended their home point streak to eight games (7-0-1).

### NYI AT HOME:

The New York Islanders have earned at least one point in each of their last nine home games dating back to Jan. 13. The Islanders are 8-0-1 over that stretch with their only loss coming in a 1-0 shootout loss against the Tampa Bay Lightning on Feb. 1. NYI is 18-7-4 at home this season, earning 40 points in 29 home games.

Islanders rookie defenseman, **Devon Toews** recorded a pair of assists in Saturday's 5-2 win over the Edmonton Oilers, earning his first career multi-point game. Toews' plus-9 rating is good for ninth-best among NHL rookies.

The New York Islanders are currently in a stretch of playing six-straight games against Canadian teams (3 at home & 3 on the road). The Islanders are 4-1-1 against Canadian teams this year and 1-0-0 north of the boarder.
