## BLUE JACKETS TEAM NOTES

- The Blue Jackets improved to 38-27-3 (79 pts) with the victory to move into the second Wild Card spot in the Eastern Conference.
- Columbus is now 6-3-1 in the last 10 home contests against Pittsburgh. The victory snapped the Jackets' overall eight-game skid against the Pens (0-5-3).
- The Blue Jackets went three-for-three on the penalty kill tonight and have killed off 67-of-73 opponent power plays since Dec. 31 (91.8%).
- The club improved to 27-5-2 when scoring first this season. CBJ also improved to 22-4-0 when leading after the first period and 24-2-0 when leading after two periods.
- The Blue Jackets have scored six shorthanded goals this season with four recorded at home.
- Tonight was the 12<sup>th</sup> sellout crowd of the season at Nationwide Arena with 19,146 people in attendance. It's the largest crowd of the season at home and the sixth-largest crowd for a regular season home contest in franchise history.



## BLUE JACKETS PLAYER/COACH NOTES

- RW **Cam Atkinson** notched his 17<sup>th</sup> multi-point game and seventh multi-goal game of the campaign with 2-0-2. He tied the franchise mark for most multi-goal contests in a single season (Rick Nash in 2010-11 and Atkinson in 2016-17).

- Atkinson tallied his fourth shorthanded goal of the campaign on his first of the night, tying for the second-most in a single season in CBJ history (Nash, 2007-08; Vyborny, 2003-04). It's one shy of the franchise mark (Rick Nash; 2008-09).
- The shorthanded tally stood as the game winner, marking Atkinson's eighth game-winner of the campaign. It is one short of tying the single season franchise record he set in 2016-17 (9).
- C **Boone Jenner** scored the first goal of the game and is now two goals shy of 100 career NHL/CBJ goals.
- RW **Oliver Bjorkstrand** scored the Jackets' third goal of the game and now has 3-1-4 in his last six home games.
- RW **Josh Anderson** assisted on Jenner's goal for his 100<sup>th</sup> career CBJ/NHL point (59-41-100; 227 GP).
- D **Zach Werenski** assisted on Atkinson's empty net goal, giving him 0-6-6 in his last nine contests.
- LW **Nick Foligno** tallied an assist on Jenner's goal and has 1-1-2 over his last two home contests.
- LW **Ryan Dzingel** notched an assist on Bjorkstrand's goal, giving him 0-3-3 in his last five home games. He finished with 1-5-6 in six games this season against Pittsburgh.
- C **Matt Duchene** tallied an assist on Bjorkstrand's goal, giving him 3-2-5 in five games against the Penguins this year.
