TEAM NOTES

The Avalanche wrapped up its season series against the Hurricanes, finishing 1-1-0. Carolina earned its first regulation win in Colorado since Feb. 1, 1994, when the Hartford Whalers defeated the Quebec Nordiques, 2-1. Colorado entered tonight's contest with a 12-0-3 (12 wins, 2 ties, 1 OT loss) home record against the Hurricanes dating back to the start of the 1996-97 season.

Colorado is now 15-10-6 against the Eastern Conference this season, including an 8-5-2 record at home against the East.

The Avs are 5-1-1 in their last seven outings at Pepsi Center.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Nathan MacKinnon finished with seven shots and now has 304 on the season, becoming just the third player (fourth time) in franchise history to record 300 or more shots in a single season (Joe Sakic: 339 in 1995-96 and 332 in 2000-01; Claude Lemieux: 315 in 1995-96). MacKinnon has registered at least one shot in 139 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the NHL (Dougie Hamilton, 233).

Colin Wilson matched a season high with five shots (3x - last: Feb. 7 at Washington).

Petr Mrazek earned his fourth shutout of the season and the 18th of his career.

Andrei Svechnikov matched a season/career high with two goals (also: Dec. 13 vs. Montreal).
