BLUE JACKETS TEAM NOTES

- The Blue Jackets improved to 39-28-3 (81 pts) with the victory to remain in the second Wild Card spot in the Eastern Conference.
- Columbus improved to 7-3-3 in its last 13 games against Boston, including 4-1-2 in the last seven home games.
- CBJ tied a season high with seven goals (fifth time; MR: Jan. 13 vs. NYR).
- The club scored multiple goals in all three periods of a game for the third time this season (Nov. 26 at DET, 7-5 W; Jan. 13 vs. NYR, 7-5 W).
- The Jackets finished three-for-three on the penalty kill tonight and have killed off 72-of-78 opponent power plays since Dec. 31 (92.3%).
- The Blue Jackets improved to 23-4-0 when leading after the first period and 25-2-0 when leading after the second period.
- Tonight was the second time in the past three games that the Jackets have scored a shorthanded goal (seven on season and five at home).



BLUE JACKETS PLAYER/COACH NOTES

- **C Boone Jenner** scored his first career hat trick tonight. It's his third multi-goal game and ninth multi-point game of the season. He had scored two goals eight times prior to the hat trice (MR: Jan. 10, 2019 vs. NSH). He notched his 100th career NHL goal on his second of the game.

- RW **Josh Anderson** recorded his first career three-assist and four-point game (1-3-4). It's his sixth multi-point game of the campaign. He reached the 40-point mark on the season with the effort (23-17-40 in 70 games).
- D **Zach Werenski** tallied 1-3-4 tonight, the first four-point game and second three-assist contest (Feb. 13, 2018 at NYI). He has points in three-straight home games (1-5-6) and points in six of his last seven home games (1-8-9).
- LW **Ryan Dzingel** scored his first goal as a Blue Jacket and added two assists for his first career three-point contest. He reached the 50-point mark on the campaign with the effort (23-27-50 in 66 games).
- C **Riley Nash** recorded two assists tonight for his second multi-point game of the season (MR: Nov. 29 vs. MIN; 1-1-2). He matched a career high with his ninth two-assist outing (MR: Mar. 13, 2018 at CAR).
- C **Matt Duchene** scored his 29th goal of the season and the Jackets' fourth of the game. He has 1-1-2 in back-to-back home contests.
- LW **Artemi Panarin** tallied an assist on Werenski's power-play goal, leaving him six assists shy of 200 in his NHL career. He has points in five of his last seven home contests (1-6-7). He also fought Charlie McAvoy in the second period for his second career fight (vs. Scottie Upshall on Nov. 9, 2016 at STL) and finished with a career-high seven penalty minutes.
- D **Seth Jones** assisted on Dzingel's goal, giving him assists in three-straight home games (0-3-3) and points in four of his last five home outings (2-2-4).
- LW **Nick Foligno** notched an assist on Jenner's goal, giving him points in three of his last four home games (1-2-3).
