BLUE JACKETS TEAM NOTES

- The Blue Jackets won their second-straight game and third in the past four, improving to 40-28-3 (83 pts) on the campaign to remain in the second Wild Card spot in the Eastern Conference.
- Columbus improved to 5-2-2 in the past nine games against Carolina and 4-2-0 in the last six home contests against the club. The teams split the season series 2-2-0.
- Columbus is now 28-5-2 when scoring first this season, 24-4-0 when leading after the first period and 25-2-0 when leading the second.
- The Jackets were perfect on the penalty kill for the fourth-straight game, killing off both of the Hurricanes' power-play chances. They have killed off all opponent power-play opportunities in 28 of the last 33 outings since Dec. 31 (74-of-80; 92.5%).
- Columbus scored a shorthanded goal for the second-straight game and third in the past four (eight total on campaign).
- Tonight was the 13th sellout of the season at Nationwide Arena. It's the most sellouts in a campaign since 2003-04 (16).



BLUE JACKETS PLAYER/COACH NOTES

- G **Sergei Bobrovsky** stopped all 46 shots he faced tonight for his sixth shutout of the season. The 46 saves are a career-high in a shutout as well as the most in a shutout win in franchise history. It surpassed the 45 save

shutouts recorded by Steve Mason on Jan. 9, 2009 at Washington and Apr. 9, 2010 vs. Detroit. The 46 shots are also single-game season highs for saves and shots (44 saves on 45 shots on 11/1 at SJS).

- D **Adam McQuaid** notched his first goal/point with the Blue Jackets.
- D **David Savard** scored his fifth goal of the season and second at home.
- RW **Josh Anderson** scored his second shorthanded goal of the season. He has recorded points in three-straight home games (2-4-6).
- D **Seth Jones** assisted on Anderson's goal and now has points in four-straight home contests (1-3-4).
- C **Boone Jenner** notched an assist on Savard's goal, giving him points in his last three-straight games (4-1-5).
- LW **Artemi Panarin** assisted on McQuaid's goal leaving him five assists shy of 200 in his NHL career. He has points in six of his last eight home contests (1-7-8).
- RW **Cam Atkinson** tallied an assist on McQuaid's goal and now has points in five of his last eight home games (4-3-7).
