## Philadelphia Flyers: Head Coach and Player Bios

### Head Coach: Alain Vigneault

Alain Vigneault was named the 21<sup>st</sup> head coach in Flyers history on April 15, 2019.

Vigneault, 58, brings 1,216 games of experience as an NHL head coach to Philadelphia over parts of 16 seasons. He served as the head coach of the New York Rangers for five seasons (2013-18), the Vancouver Canucks for seven seasons (2006-13) and the Montreal Canadiens for parts of four seasons (1997-2000).

Vigneault has 's teams have won seven division championships and have made the playoffs 11 times, advancing past the first round on eight of those occasions, and reaching the Stanley Cup Final with Vancouver in 2010-11 and the Rangers in 2013-14. Three of Vigneault's teams have earned the Presidents' Trophy –Vancouver on two occasions, 2010-11 and 2011-12, and the Rangers in 2014-15. Individually, Vigneault won the Jack Adams Award as the NHL Coach of the Year in 2006-07 and was a finalist for the award on three other occasions, in 1997-98, 2010-11 and 2014-15.

**HOLTBEAST**

- Braden Holtby stopped 26 of the 28 shots he faced during Monday's game against the Tampa Bay Lightning.
- With the 26 save effort, Braden Holtby eclipsed 2,500 career playoff saves (2,506), which ranks 19th all-time.
- Monday's game also marked the 55th time Holtby allowed two or fewer goals in the playoffs, which is the 16th most all-time among any goaltender since 1979 and the third most among active goaltenders (Henrik Lundqvist: 74; Marc-Andre Fleury: 66). In his playoff career, Holtby has allowed two or fewer goals in 61.1 percent of his playoff games, the sixth-highest percentage in NHL history among goaltenders with at least 90 games played and the highest among active players.

- Holtby is the franchise leader in playoff wins (48), save percentage (.928) and goals against average (2.09) and shutouts (7).
- Additionally, Holtby's .928 playoff save percentage is the highest in NHL history among goaltenders with at least 60 games played, while his 2.09 goals against average is tied for fourth in NHL history (Turk Broda: 1.98; Dominik Hasek and Martin Brodeur: 2.02; Chris Osgood: 2.09).
- Prior to the season suspension, Holtby was on pace to record his sixth consecutive season with at least 30 wins, which would have made him the 10th goaltender in NHL history to accomplish the feat and one of just three active goaltenders (Henrik Lundqvist and Ryan Miller: each with seven consecutive seasons from 2005-06 to 2011-12).

## **TOP CAPS FACTS**

### **THE GREAT 8**

- Alex Ovechkin has scored 26 goals in his last 27 games.
- Ovechkin is in the midst of his 12th career postseason, where he currently ranks first among active players in playoff goals per game (65g in 129 games, 0.50 goals per game) and tied for third in points per game (0.98 points per game). Ovechkin's 129 career playoff games are tied for 16th among active players.
- Ovechkin is the franchise's all-time leader in playoff games (129), goals (65), points (126), power play goals (24), power play points (53) and game-winning goals (9).
- In 30 career games played at Scotiabank Arena — which includes 25 regular season, four playoff and one exhibition game — Ovechkin has recorded 40 points (28g, 12a).
- The NHL doesn't keep record of goals scored during preseason or exhibition games, but if Ovechkin also scores in the month of August, he will become the first player in franchise history to score a goal in every month of the calendar year (Evgeny Kuznetsov is also eligible to achieve this feat).

### **KUZ CONTROL**

- With a goal on Monday against the Tampa Bay Lightning, Evgeny Kuznetsov tied Dale Hunter (25) for the fourth-most playoff goals in franchise history. Kuznetsov reached the 25 goal mark in 29 fewer games than Hunter.
- Additionally, Kuznetsov is now just two points shy of tying both Mike Ridley and John Carlson for the fourth most points in franchise history.
- Since making his playoff debut in the 2014-15 season, Kuznetsov's 58 points are tied with Arizona's Phil Kessel for the sixth-most in the NHL, and his 39 points over the last three postseasons is tied for second in the NHL.
- Kuznetsov is one of just nine players in the 2020 NHL Stanley Cup Playoffs with at least 70 playoff games played since 2014-15.
- During the Capitals' 2018 Stanley Cup championship, Kuznetsov's 32 points (12g, 20a) set a franchise record for the most points in a single postseason. It also marks the most points a single player has recorded in a single postseason since 2009-10.

### **LEADING THE WAY**

- John Carlson is the franchise's playoff leader among defensemen in games (107), goals (18) and points (60). Carlson is also three assists shy of passing Scott Stevens (44) for the most playoff assists in franchise history by a defenseman.
- This season, Carlson's 75 points in 69 games (15g, 60a) led all defensemen, finishing 10 points ahead of the next highest scoring defenseman (Nashville's Roman Josi: 65 points) and 20 points ahead of the third-highest scoring defenseman (Tampa Bay's Victor Hedman: 55 points), who along with Carlson are Norris Trophy Candidates.
- Carlson's 1.09 points per game were the highest total by a defenseman since Ray Bourque, Al MacInnis and Sergei Zubov in the 1993-94 season. As the highest scoring defenseman, Bourque won the Norris Trophy that season.
- Only 13 other defensemen in NHL history recorded at least 1.09 points per game in a single season after playing 69 games. Nine of the 13 defensemen have won the Norris Trophy in their career.
- Carlson was the only defenseman this season to average 1.09 points per game. The last time only one defenseman averaged at least 1.09 points per game in a season was 1988-89 (Paul Coffey: 113 points in 75 games).

### **FOURTH LINE EFFICIENCY**

- Richard Panik scored his first career playoff goal on Monday against Tampa Bay.
- From Dec. 14 to the regular season finale (March 9), Panik led the Capitals in points per 60 minutes of five-on-five play (3.18) and ranked seventh in the NHL among players with at least 30 games played in that span. He averaged the fewest five-on-five minutes per game (10:28) among players to rank in the top-50 in this respective category.
- Panik has primarily played with Nic Dowd and Garnet Hathaway. Including both the regular season and playoffs, the trio has skated for 55:31 together at five-on-five and have recorded a 56.56 shot attempt percentage (56 shot attempts for, 43 against), a 60.34 shots for percentage (35 shots for, 23 against) and have outscored opponents 4 to 2.

### **VERSUS PHILADELPHIA**

- The Capitals are 16-13 all-time against the Flyers in the playoffs.
- In their most recent playoff matchup in 2016 First Round, the Capitals won the series 4-2, outscoring the Flyers 14 to 6.
- Alex Ovechkin leads the Capitals with six goals and 14 points (7g, 7a) against Philadelphia in the playoffs.



- In his six career playoff games against the Flyers, Braden Holtby is 4-2 with a 0.84 goals against average, a .968 save percentage and two shutouts.

#### **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

**Disciplined Hockey** - Monday's game against the Tampa Bay Lightning marked the first playoff game in franchise history the Capitals didn't go shorthanded in a game.

**Sweet Nicky** - Nicklas Backstrom ranks first on the franchise's playoff assist list (71) and second in games played (124), goals (36) and points (107). His four playoff overtime goals are the most in franchise history, and no other player has more than two. Backstrom is one of just four active players with at least four playoff overtime goals (Patrick Kane: 5; Corey Perry and Patrick Marleau: 4).

**Big Willy** - Over the last three postseasons, Tom Wilson has averaged 0.69 points per game (20 points in 29 playoff games), tied for the sixth-highest rate on the Capitals during that span. Wilson also leads the NHL in hits (140) over the last three postseasons. This season, Wilson recorded a career high 44 points (21g, 23a) this season, also setting a new career high in assists.

**Young V** - During the 2019-20 season, Jakub Vrana set career highs in both goals (25), even strength goals (24) and assists (27), despite having 13 games remaining on the schedule. Vrana was on pace to score 28 even-strength goals over an 82-game season and become one of two players in NHL history to reach the mark while averaging less than 15 minutes per game (Vrana: 14:53 TOI; Chicago's Dominik Kubalik 26 ESG and 14:22 TOI).

**Comeback Kids** - This season, the Capitals won 21 games after trailing by at least one goal, tied with the St. Louis Blues for the most instances in the NHL. Washington also held a 17-16-3 record when they allowed the first goal, the second-highest win percentage in the NHL (.472). Additionally, the Capitals' 11-12-3 record when trailing after the first period marked the second-highest win percentage in the NHL (.423), while their 9-17-2 record when trailing after the second period marked the highest win percentage in the NHL (.321). Over the last two postseasons, the Capitals lead the NHL with a .333 win percentage when they trail after the second period (3-6).

**Heavy Hitters** - This season, the Capitals had five players ranked in the top-30 in the NHL in hits (Tom Wilson: 253 hits, ranked 3rd in the NHL; Brenden Dillon: 194 hits, ranked 13th; Garnet Hathaway: 189 hits, ranked 17th; Alex Ovechkin: 184 hits, tied for 18th; Radko Gudas: 164 hits; tied for 30th).
